WORKSHOPS

[A] FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES: WHAT ARE THEY AND HOW DO YOU GET THEM?

This workshop will provide an overview of the vast array of Family Support Services. Services to be discussed include community habilitation, family reimbursement, housing assistance services, recreation programs, home modification and Project Connect, an information and referral service.

[B] HOW TO CREATE A SENSORY ENVIRONMENT

Every individual on the autism spectrum experiences the world differently from a sensory point of view. This talk will provide a brief background on the neurobiological evidence for sensory differences in ASD and then provide practical guidance on creating sensory friendly environments with a particular focus on the home environment. Several sensory sensitivities will be covered generally, and specific examples will be provided to illustrate individual preferences and needs.
